To All To Whom These Presents Shall Come:

- WHEREAS, This year marks the sixth anniversary of the launch of 811, a national "Call Before You Dig" phone number designated by the Federal Communications Commission to eliminate the confusion of multiple "Call Before You Dig" numbers; and
- WHEREAS, Calling 811 can prevent injury to workers, reduce expenses to the public and minimize damages to underground utilities; and
- WHEREAS, National Safe Digging Month (NSDM) takes a time-tested marketing concept – an awareness month – and applies it to safe digging at a strategic time of year when digging is at its peak in many areas; and
- WHEREAS, The celebration of NSDM in April reflects the start of spring with natural connections to Earth Day and Arbor Day; and
- WHEREAS, Kentucky's 811 number is the only statewide, around-the-clock resource for identifying underground facility locations, with all major utilities voluntarily participating;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, STEVEN L. BESHEAR, Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, do hereby proclaim April 2013 as
